### EAA Zenith Showplane Parking



Zenith showplane parking will be just north of the Homebuilders center on the flight line in its usual place across from the Zenith factory display. Please follow the NOTAMS instructions for signage for parking, and add another sign that says "ZENITH". When you get near the parking area flagmen will help get you to the location requested. Most of the parking volunteers know what Zenith airplanes look like, but any extra signage helps! Once your aircraft is parked, EAA's policy is no engine operations in the parking area and the aircraft will need to be pushed to the east of the safety line for engine start. If you are anticipating demonstrating or flying any of the aircraft during the convention, park your aircraft as close to the flightline as you can.



## Accommodations

The Oshkosh Elks Lodge has a very large parking area and they are offering motor home parking for \$20 per night for anyone coming to the banquet before coming to the EAA. #### **Directions**

The Elks Lodge is very easy to find! If you are taking Highway 41 north, take the Highway 44 exit, which is also called South Park Ave. If you are coming from the EAA, follow the flagman out of the grounds and turn right on South Park Ave. Follow South Park NE and turn left on Oregon St. Follow Oregon St. north to Fernau Ave. and turn right. The Elks Lodge is just 100 yards from the corner on the right hand side. There is ample free parking in both lots at the Elks. If the lots are full, there is free parking on both sides of the street in front of the Elks. Large motor homes and campers that are not spending the night must park on the street.

#### What's New for 2016? Meet Sam!

Light Sport Aircraft (LSA) version (at 1,320 lbs. gross weight) or Amateur-Built Experimental (AB-E) at 1,440 lbs. gross weight. Wing span 28.5 feet (Note: the award-winning flying prototype meets the LSA definition).

Amateur-Built Experimental (AB-E) at 1,800 lbs. with option to install heavier engines such as the Lycoming 0-320 at 160HP or modern auto conversions. Wing span 32 feet. Sport Aerobatic Configuration (AB-E / LSA): Wing span 25.25 feet. 2 people at 1440 lbs limited aerobatics or 1 person at 1,200 lbs., full g load aerobatics as per FAR 23.
